
Overview



- Survey participants included students from the final year of various degree programs, including B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., M.A., and M.Sc.




1. All of your syllabi are covered in the class.




2. Your Professors come well prepared to the class.




3. Professors are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. 158 responses




4. What percentage of Professors in your department use ICT tools such as LCD Projector, animations and software, etc. while teaching?


5. Do your Professors provide you with additional study material / notes and other learning inputs for clarity and understanding of the subject?


6. The Professors illustrate concepts through examples and applications.




7. Your Professors are able to communicate effectively.




8. Complaint Redressal Committee in the College is good 158 responses




9. There is adequate provision for drinking water facility.




11. The Professors identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges












16. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




17. Teachers encourage students to participate in extracurricular activities 158 responses




18. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
