

STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS) -YEAR 2021-2022

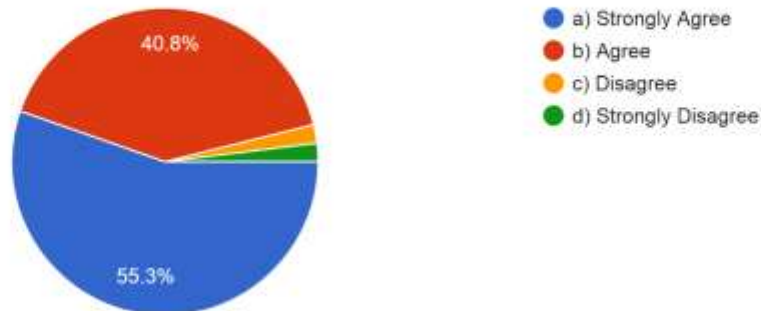

- The students from final year B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., M.A., and M.Sc., are involved in the survey.

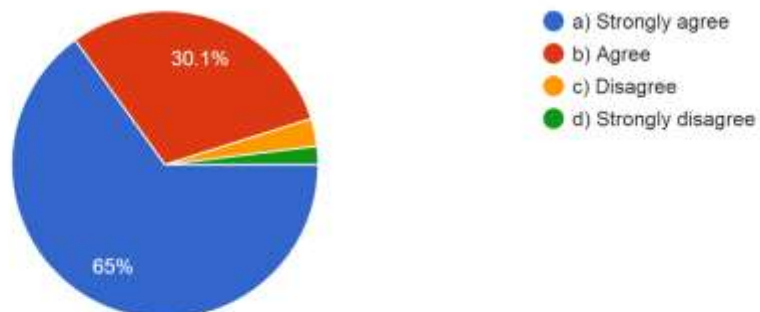

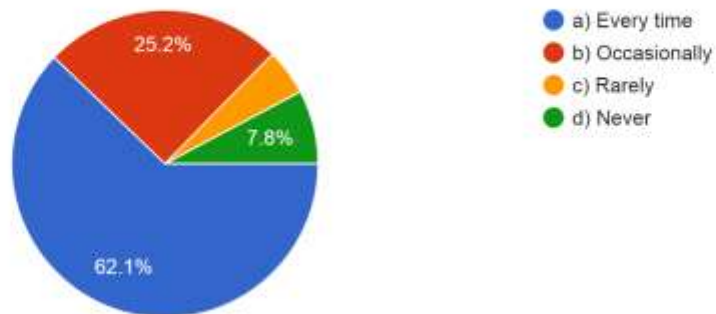
2. Your Professors come well prepared to the class.

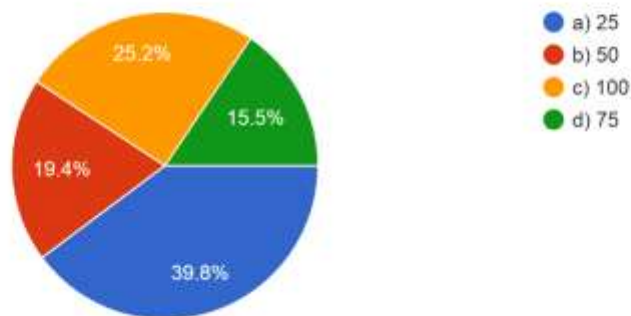
3. Professors are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

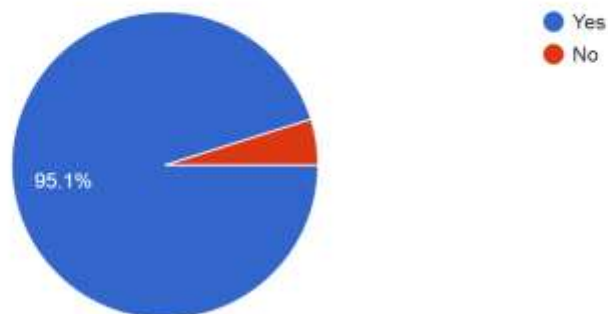
4. What percentage of Professors in your department use ICT tools such as LCD Projector, animations and software, etc. while teaching?

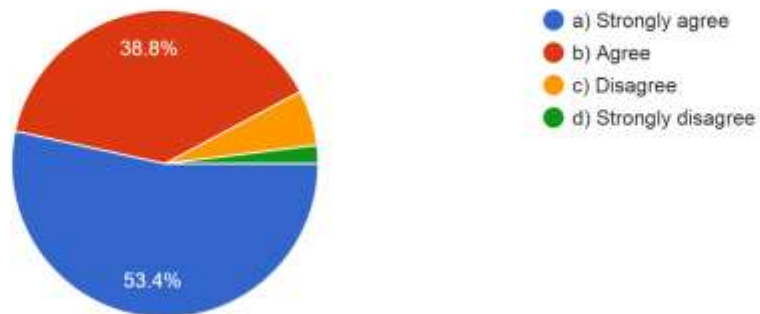

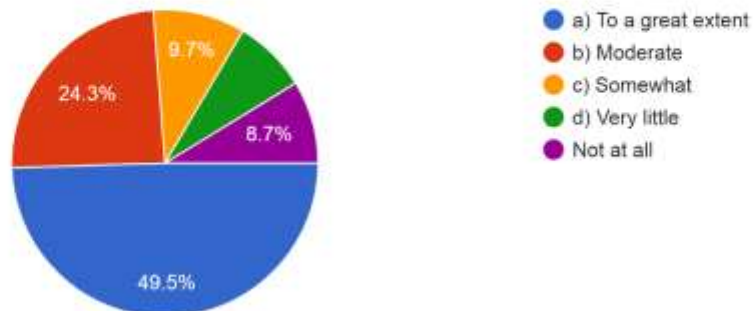

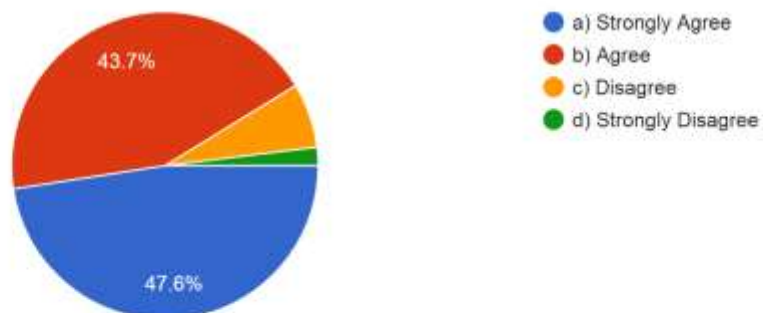

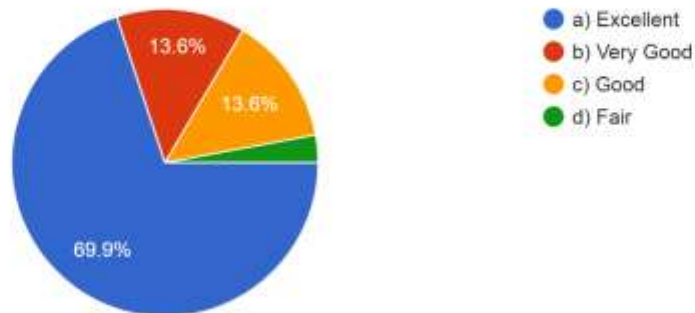
